Trip to France Wednesday 19th June to Friday 21st June 2019

The Communications Faculty is offering students of French in KS3 the opportunity to visit France. This visit will complement the study of French and will provide opportunities to practice the language, be in a French environment and visit some cultural sites. The students will visit the Old Town of Boulogne, Nausicaa (A French Sea Life Centre), the historic City of Amiens and the War memorial in Albert.

Itinerary

Wednesday 19th June

Very early morning departure (around 05.45) for travel to Calais.

Eurotunnel or ferry tbc and travel to Boulogne

Free time in the Old Town

Visit to Nausicaa – an extensive aquarium / Sea Life Centre

Check in to accommodation half board

Thursday 20th June

Breakfast

Visit to Amiens

Afternoon to visit War memorial at Albert

Friday 21st June

Breakfast and depart from hotel

Travel to Wierry-Effroy for visit to a Boulangerie

Further visit of a town and return travel arriving back at school around 8.15 pm

Please note - Students must be picked up from school upon return

This trip will be non-school uniform and appropriate footwear should be worn. There will be a lot of walking. Students should wear suitable clothes which will be dependent on the weather.

We invite those who would like their child to participate to pay £230 to cover the cost of transport, breakfasts and an evening meal, accommodation, insurance and entrance fees to the activities mentioned above.
